JHC HomeCare - Open for Business!

JHC HomeCare became a Certified Home Health Agency with approval from the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations as of March, 2010. At the time of this writing we have a caseload of 30 homecare patients. Most of the referrals have come from our own subacute program, whereby patients continue with their rehabilitation in their private residence upon discharge. We have a team of Registered Nurses, Physical and Occupational Therapists, and Home Health Aides.



We are able to service individuals wherever they reside, including rest homes and assisted living facilities. As we grow, we will be marketing our program to other subacute facilities that discharge patients for homecare.

Homecare is a natural outgrowth for our campus. More individuals are being discharged directly home from acute hospital stays, arranging for their rehabilitation at home. All indications are that the provision of healthcare services is moving toward the individual's private residence. The JHC will be well positioned for the future in the delivery of home services. The JHC HomeCare service area includes: Auburn, Boylston, Charlton, Grafton, Holden, Leicester, Millbury, Northborough, Oxford, Paxton, Princeton, Rutland, Shrewsbury, Spencer, Sterling, Sutton, Westboro, West Boylston and Worcester

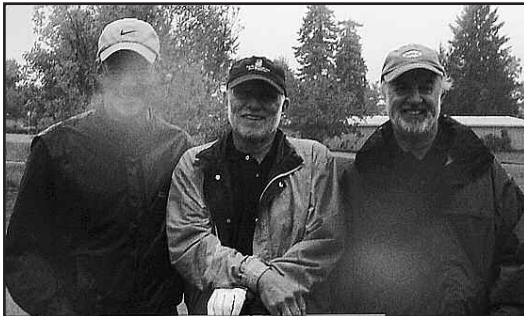
The 35th Annual Golf Classic....”Life isn’t about waiting for the storm to pass, it’s about learning to dance in the rain”.

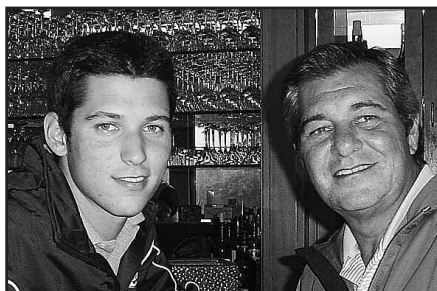
